David Rodrigues and other raised the issue of increased in house tax and what has happened to the last resolution in this matter, Sarpanch explained that house tax has been imposed as per the notification issued by Government of goa and the rate so finalised were placed before the gramsabha dated 30/04/2023 and it was accepted by gramsabha then and hence the imposition of new rates of tax were implemented during the last gramsabha it was explained as per the provisions of Sec 6(4) to Gramsabha members while discussing the same issue. Since the resolution taken in the last gramsabha was contrary to the rules made under GPRA 1994 and the same was not binding on the Panchayat. it is further resolved to write to higher authority for advice in the matter
