6(1)	Setting up of New electric Sub-station in Borim	Pro: Sudesh Borkar Sec: Rahul naik	Shri Sudesh Borkar brought to the notice of the gramsabha that Borim Village is often faces interuption in power supply. And there is a casual reply that the power interruption is from Shiroda Sub-station as a result there is hardship to contact Sub-station Shiroda. Taking into the consideration the hardship of people of borim it was resolved to setup new Sub-station in Borim, wherein the cables should be connected directly from Curti, Ponda and not from Bethoda/Shiroda

6(2)	Proposal for new electricity Sub-Station for Borikars in Bori Village and also requested to ensure the cabling for sub-station comes from directly from Curti-Ponda Department and via Bethoda-Shiroda	Pro: Sudesh Borkar Sec: Rahul naik	Shri Sudesh Borkar brought to the notice of the gramsabha that out of total electricity bill paid by the consumers 0.5 % of that bill are the charged for street light. He also highlighted that this is an additional burden on the consumers nor the department is taking full responsibility of the street light and it was resolved that electricity department should either stop the extra burden on the consumer through that 0.5 % charges or take full responsibility of street light without depending upon the local bodies
6(3)	Village borim to explore as tourism place.		Shri. Sudesh Borkar emphasized on tourism activities in Borim like Botanical farm, spice farm, beautification of springs However Sarpanch replied that Village Panchayat has not received any proposal for the same. However any proposal which can promote tourism and if received by the Panchayat supported with proper documents it will be submitted to the concern department for execution

Satish Naik explained the followup taken with regards to road, Power supply and water supply in Borim. The proposal for jack well and booster pump along with filtration system to supply tap water to Dabar Shirshirem is pending for financial approval with Government of Goa, However Gramsabha insisted to write to Finance Department to know the status of approval

6(6)	Modification in house tax rates		Sarpanch explained and requested Secretary to read out the letter received from, Director, Directorate of panchayats, wherein it was directed to implement the rates of house tax as per gazette notification dated 17/02/2022 Hence modification in house tax is not feasible, Gramsabha member Shri. Utkarsh Borkar and Sudesh Borkar resisted strongly and demanded the old rates. The gramsabha was also briefed regarding Sec 6/4 of GPRA 1994
6(7)	Widening and repair of sharp dangerous right turn on route from Aksan-Borim Panchayat Border at Adulshem		Gramsabha was of the opinion that widening of the internal roads will disturb the habitation of the people along the roadside, However Sarpanch told that if the NOC from the land owner is obtained the proposal can be send to PWD for widening of the road from Aksan to Adulshem
6(8)	Playground for students of Govt. Primary school, Tamshirem Borim		Sarpanch told that the application to come from GPS Tamshirem/School Managment committee GPS Tamshirem Towards development of playground infront of the school

6(9)	Borim village to be changed to its original name "BORI"		Sarpanch told the gramsabha that if at all the name has to be changed from Borim to Bori it is direct amendment to revenue records as Borim is recorded in the revenue records of the Village. And if at all gramsabha insists to change the name of the village from Borim to Bori it is to be reflected in the agenda of gramsabha/special gramsabha. And if 2/3 quorum is reached than only is it feasible. Gramsabha was after view that 2/3 quorum is not feasible

However after intervening of Sarpanch it was resolved to write to the government and specially PWD Minister, Government of Goa that a not a single residential house to be demolished in the whole process of acquisition/construction of highlevel bridge which passes through Village Borim and the Chief Minister of Goa should stand with his statement made on the floor of the house in the legislative assembly of Goa. and it was resolved to hold meeting with CM and PWD Minister of Goa to have discussion across the table regarding the matter</p>
